The School of Arts and Letters, Atkinson Faculty of Liberal and Professional Studies, York University, invites applications for a tenure stream appointment at the Assistant Professor level in the field of RELIGIOUS STUDIES/BIBLICAL STUDIES, to commence on July 1, 2006. All positions at York University are subject to budgetary approval.

Applicants for this position will be able to teach materials related to both the Old Testament as well as the New Testament from an historical and literary perspective. The candidate will also be expected to teach a Humanities General Education course examining selected biblical texts (Old and New Testament) in their historical and literary context. Depending upon program requirements and the specialist's specific interests, the opportunity exists to teach upper-level Humanities courses on Old Testament, New Testament, Feminist Theology, or Religion and the Classical Tradition. The candidate will be expected to have qualifications for teaching at the graduate Level.

The School of Arts and Letters offers a well-established inter-disciplinary Program in Religious Studies, together with programs in English, History, Humanities, and Culture and Expression. The university is a secular institution.

Requirements: Applicants must have a Ph.D. or Ph.D. completed at the

time of appointment; candidates should show excellence or the promise of excellence in teaching and in scholarly research and publication, and demonstrate evidence of an active research agenda.

Salary: Commensurate with qualifications.
